

**Inverness Fours and Small Boats Heads 2007 –
17th and 18th November 2007 –
Essential Information for Competitors**

Firstly can we encourage competitors to arrive early, register early (don't all leave it to the last minute) we can't cope with many crews registering two minutes before they want to boat ! , and, especially Novice Crews, boat early - Remember there will be time penalties for those crews late to the start.

Trailer and Car Parking - Buses must use the Sports Centre car park, which is clearly signposted. All cars not carrying small boats must be parked at the Rugby Club car park, turn left before crossing the canal. Those cars carrying small boats must park beyond the IRC Boathouse, but drivers may be requested to move their vehicles to the Rugby Club car park after unloading.

Trailers should be located as follows –

**On the towpath to the North of Tomnahurich Swing Bridge (turn right after going over the bridge)
Dundee UBC/ Glasgow UBC/**

**Close to the Jacobite Cruises Office
Aberdeen UBC / Aberdeen BC / Strathclyde UBC / RGUBC**

Two parking spaces must also be left on the immediate south side of the Jacobite Cruises office for the use of their staff

**Close to IRC Boathouse (beside tow path before reaching boathouse)
Glasgow RC / Clyde ARC**

**Beyond IRC Boathouse (beside tow path and at turning space before locked gate)
St. Andrew BC / Edinburgh UBC / LLRC, SPRC/CSRC, and (Sunday only) - Royal Navy, Glasgow Caledonian UARC and The Glasgow Academy plus all car topped small boats**

Registration - Race entry monies, bow numbers and back numbers will be dealt with at registration (the control caravan beside the boathouse). Should Clubs wish to scratch crews, alter crew composition or make other permitted changes, then these will be dealt with at Regatta Control which will be at the control caravan beside the boathouse.

PLEASE CARRY OUT THESE TASKS AS SOON AS YOU CAN AFTER ARRIVAL.

PLEASE HAVE THE CORRECT ENTRY MONEY IF AT ALL POSSIBLE (IF PAYING ON THE DAY) – THIS WILL HELP SPEED THINGS UP FOR ALL

Boating - Penalties will be applied for crews late to the start, please have respect for your fellow competitors and arrive at the start in time. It can take up to 45 minutes to row to the start.

First Division - Novice Crews must begin boating at 10:00(Saturday), 9.45(Sunday) Junior Crews at 10:20(Saturday), 9.55(Sunday) and Senior Crews at 10:30(Saturday), 10.05(Sunday). Remember to take sufficient warm and weatherproof clothing with you.

Second Division - Novice Crews must begin boating at 12.45(Saturday), 12.00(Sunday) Junior Crews at 1:05(Saturday), 12.10(Sunday) and Senior Crews at 1:15(Saturday), 12.15(Sunday). Remember to take sufficient warm and weatherproof clothing with you.
